ADMINISTRATION

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

VETMED Levamisole Pour-On contains Levamisole base, a member of the Levamisole family. It is effective against internal parasites sensitive to this family.

For accuracy, use an approved Pour-On gun. Check accuracy of Pour-On gun regularly. Apply slowly along animal's back according to live weight as shown in application table.

A representative sample of animals should be weighed before treatment either with scales or a weighband. Dose rate to be based on heaviest cattle in each group (bulls, cows stears, calves etc.). Do not underdose. Where there is a large variation in size within the group, draft into two or more lines based on liveweight, to avoid excessive overdosing. Wet animals should not be treated. Do not use if rainfall is pending.

WITHHOLD PERIODS

MILK: Milk intended for human consumption must be discarded during treatment and for no less than 24 hours following the last treatment

MEAT: Animals producing meat and offal for human consumption must not be sold for slaughter either during treatment or within 10 days of cessation of the last treatment.

COMBINED USE

Combined use of drench actives may improve efficacy and slow the development of resistance. Vetmed Levamisole Pour-On can be combined in equal volumes with Vetmed Abamectin Pour-On (A10786) to produce a stable mixture for Pour-On dosing of cattle. The mixture contains 5.0g/L Abamectin and 100g/L Levamisole. This combined solution must be well mixed before use and dosed at a rate of 1mL/10kg bodyweight. The mixture remains stable for up to 3 months if stored as per label conditions.

STORAGE

Store in the original container, tightly closed and locked up in a safe place. Store below 25°C away from direct sunlight.
